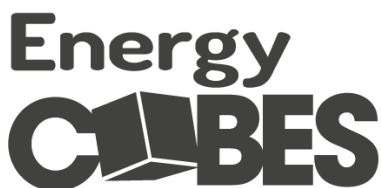


### Walk-a-thon
